

## Doctor's fees for medical certificates and reports

A doctor is paid fees for medical certificates and reports that are not related to the patient's care, as mentioned below. For a medical specialist in the field the fee is payable at a 50% increase.

1.1 A brief report which includes a description of the illness, injury or disability and a reasoned statement based on the degree of incapacity for work or inconvenience, the need for medical or other treatments and similar issues (e.g. a brief report, required for the purpose of applying for an allowance, drafted on form B, in accordance with the Health Insurance Act, or otherwise a brief report to be appended to a pension claim or an application for the care of invalids, Medical statement C) 14.19 €

1.2 A comprehensive report which includes the description of the illness, injury or disability and a detailed statement based on the degree of incapacity for work or inconvenience, the need for medication or other treatment, reimbursement status, degree of life-threatening and similar matters (e.g. a comprehensive report, required for the purpose of applying for an allowance, drafted on form B, in accordance with the Health Insurance Act, or otherwise a comprehensive report to be provided to the police, services, or other authorities) or a comprehensive and time-consuming report to be appended to a pension claim 16.22 €

1.3 Report on legal capacity (e.g. for the purpose of drafting a will, for a marriage license or making a decision in accordance with the Guardianship Services Act) 24.33 €

2 Medical certificates and reports to be issued based on an examination or treatment of a patient who has been insured by an insurance company under the Employment Accidents Insurance Act Section §, depending on the quality of the same

2.1 Standard medical certificate 10.14 €

2.2 Comprehensive certificate or report 17.74 €

2.3 Extensive and time-consuming medical certificate or report 24.33 €
